



## Permission for Display of Student Artwork<sup>1</sup>

Students own the copyright to the artwork they create as part of their coursework. The College of New Jersey is seeking your permission to collect and display your artwork as part of the Department's accreditation process with the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD). If you agree to permit the College to collect and hold your artwork as per this agreement, please complete the following form:

**1. Ownership of the Artwork:** I \_\_\_\_\_ am the creator and owner of the copyright to the artwork described below:

(a) Subject to 1(b) below, I represent that the Artwork is solely of my creation and that no other individual or parties hold any copyright interest in any portion of the work, and that use of the Artwork is not subject to any grant or restriction that would prevent its use consistent with this permission.

(b) If the Artwork incorporates another individual's or parties' copyrighted work, I represent that I have obtained permission from the copyright holder to create a derivative of, and reproduce the work as set forth in this permission.

**2. Grant of Permission:** I hereby give nonexclusive permission for the College to collect and present the Artwork to NASAD.

**3. Duration of Permission:** The permission granted herein shall last in perpetuity, beginning on the date set forth below. Notwithstanding the preceding, I may terminate this permission upon fourteen (14) days written notice to the Chair of the Department of Art and Art History.

**4. Attribution:** As creator of the Artwork, I hereby authorize and consent to the display of my name and likeness on NASAD-related materials.
