FIRST YEAR FOUNDATION PROGRAM

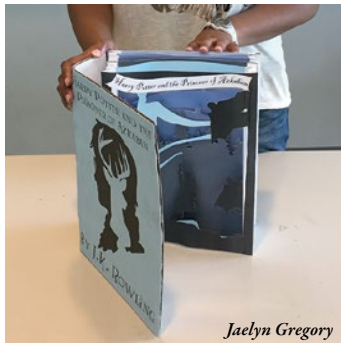
The BFA in Visual Arts and the BA in Art Education are grounded in a selection of first-year foundational courses. These studio classes give students the conceptual, theoretical, and technical problem solving skills necessary for effective visual communication. By exercising critical thinking, writing, and visual research, freshman students begin to foster their personal visions. Through meaningful engagement with contemporary and historical culture, students engage in creative discourse within their professional community and the art world at large.

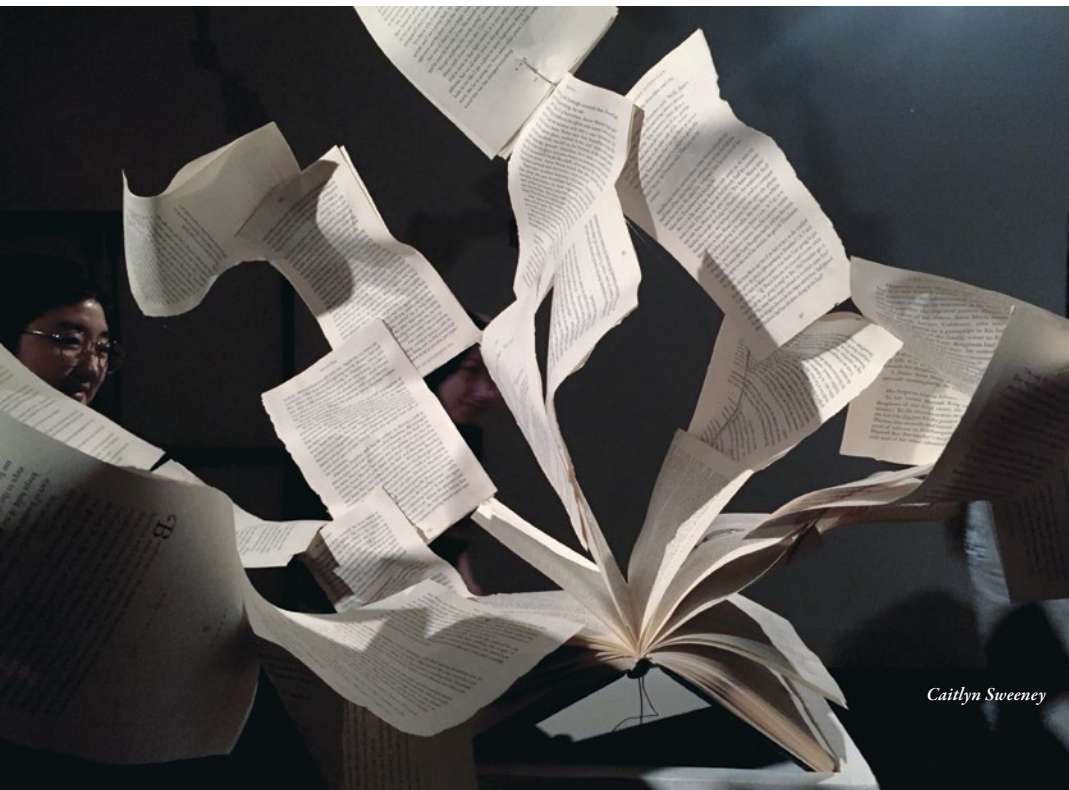
